Most tables are so much alike nowadays it's hard to tell one from the other. That's why locations keep chanting: "Bring us a new one! Bring us a new one!" every couple of weeks. Such chants subside for good once the location gets an Owl. The Mills Owl has all the player satisfying ability of the famous Mills One-Two-Three, best selling and longest running free play table of all time. The Owl uses much of the One-Two-Three basic appeal with a whole new world of entertainment added. For, you see, instead of it being a one ball like the One-Two-Three, the Owl is a FIVE BALL game and Free Play, too!

A Whole World of NEW Entertainment in Five Shots

The five ball Free Play Owl is designed to give the player more real entertainment than any table he ever played. The first shot is the *vital shot*—for that first ball is the one which turns the reels. Each bump of a reel-bumper moves the corresponding reel one notch and, if, as the first shot ends, the reels show a combination similar to any of the standard Bell pay combinations, a varying number of points is automatically recorded in favor of the player. On this

first shot alone, the player may succeed in getting the highest possible one shot score, the three Owl combination, which is exactly the same as the standard three Bar Bell combination.

The score card shows how many free games the player is entitled for the different number of points he makes by hitting Bell combinations on the first shot.

On the next four shots, the reels do not turn when a ball hits the bumpers, but points are chalked up according to the number of times the different bumpers are hit, and it is wholly possible for any player who may have missed winning free play games on his first shot, to pile up enough points on his next four "bumper shots" to win a good payout in free play games. This makes it natural and advantageous for most players to want to play out every game by shooting all five balls, since every ball has a meaning and contributes to the score. However, some players who want a lot of fast action, will be content just to keep shooting that vital first ball, which spins the reels and gives off the points in one lump. On this type of play the Mills Owl has lightning earning power.

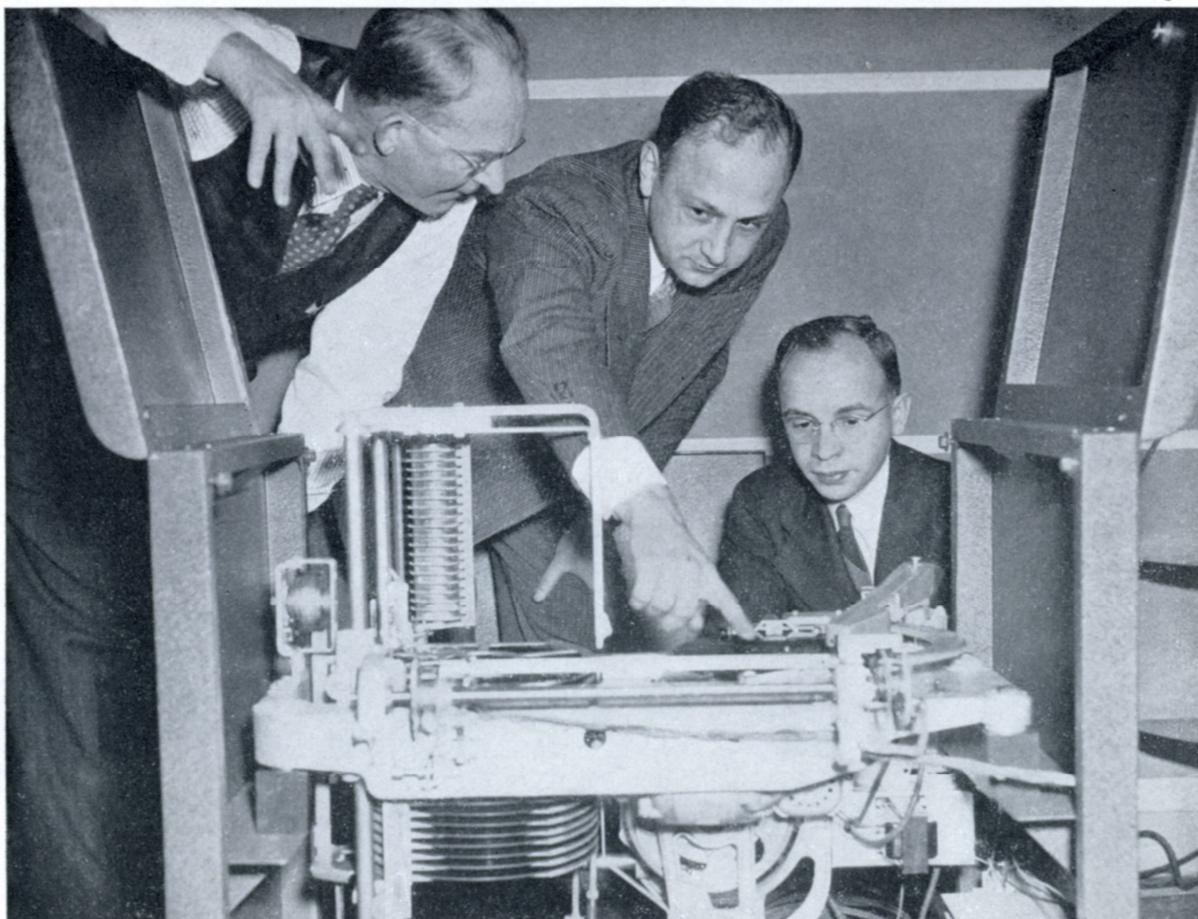


the nation's best known artist-designers, it is brilliantly decorated with bird motif, in many colors, harmonizing with natural birch. A whole new set of characters have been devised for the Owl's reels; they are: Canary instead of Lemon; Cardinal instead of Cherry; Oriole instead of Orange; Blue-bird instead of Plum; Goldfinch instead of Bell; and Owls instead of Bars. On the light box only one character on a reel shows at a time, giving the appearance of a flat surface, and preventing impression of the characters being on reels at all.
