

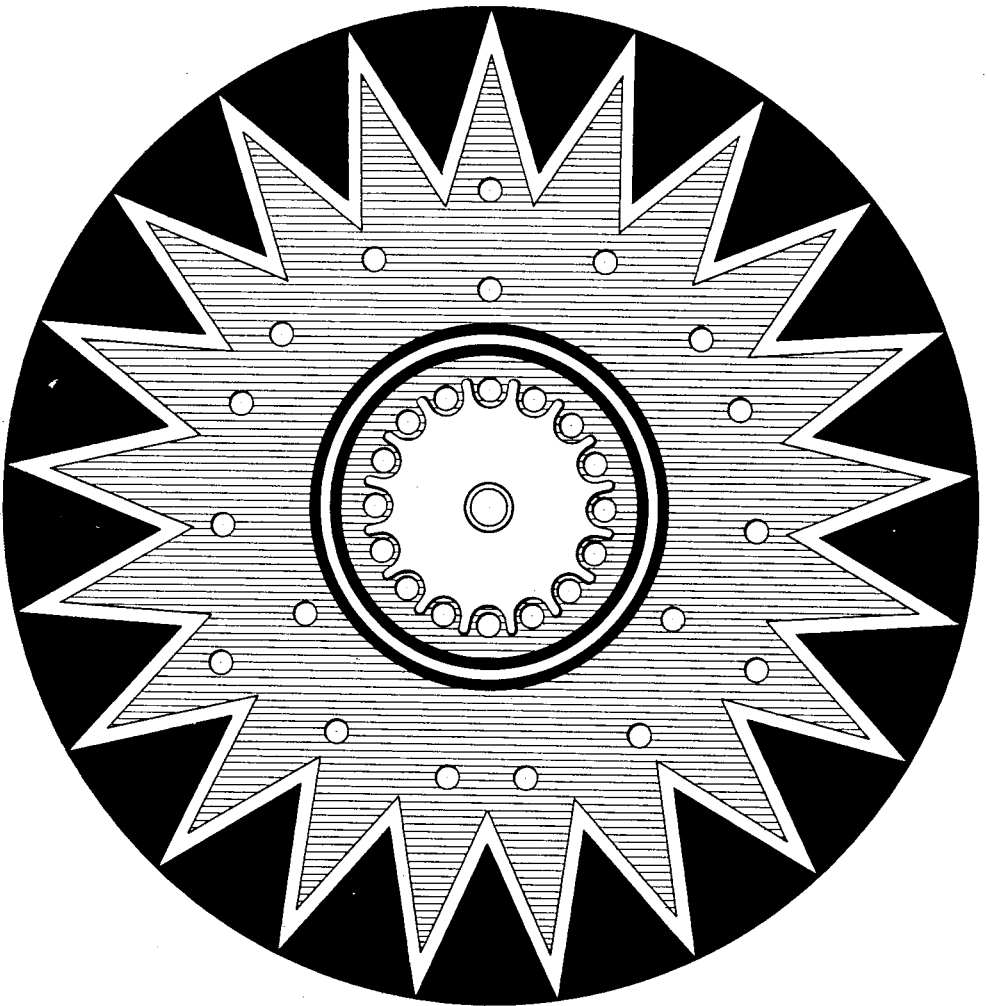

DESIGN FOR A GAME BOARD

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALBERT J. WATLING, a citizen of the United States, residing in Chicago, county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Game Board, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a game board embodying my new design.
