As with all coin operated equipment manufactured by the Chicago Coin Machine Division of Chicago Dynamic Industries, Inc., COMMANDO MACHINE GUN has been scientifically designed, skillfully constructed and is giving trouble free operation on an extended service basis.

COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERIES are in operation in various parts of the United States and in many countries overseas. The operators who have joined the legion of COMMANDO owners are quite elated with the profit making capabilities of their installation. Reports verify that COMMANDO is providing not merely efficient operating equipment but is putting each owner and/or operator in a steady money making enterprise with spectacularly speedy return of the original investment, and continuing earning power thereafter.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The usual five Gun COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERY consists of:

- Five (5) Commando Machine Guns
- One (1) Target Set Up
- One (1) Pellet Cleaning Machine
- Five (5) Sets of Plexiglass Protection
- One (1) Pellet Return Trough
- One (1) Ping Pong Ball Mechanism
(including one gross of balls)
- 80,000 Pellets

COMMANDO MACHINE GUN DIVISION of Chicago Dynamic Industries, Inc. supplies the above equipment plus various optional extras as listed on our enclosed price list. The actual physical structure, that is, the wiring, housing, counter, signs, etc. are the responsibility of the purchaser. We do furnish a complete set of plans and a wiring diagram showing the suggested installation. The plans, as supplied, show the construction as recommended by our technical staff. Experience has shown that by following the factory plans as closely as is feasible, the resulting installation provides an efficiently operating, eye appealing set up.

The five Gun COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERY requires a space 12 ft. in width by 23 ft. in depth. The 12 ft. dimension allows for comfortable spacing of the Guns and the 23 ft. depth is considered an absolute minimum. In respect to the depth of the booth, if more than 23 ft. is available, we recommend that a greater depth be utilized. This increased shooting range adds to the fascinating appeal of the Gallery.

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DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT

1. GUN - COMMANDO MACHINE GUN is a self-contained air actuated machine gun which fires a 7/32" case hardened steel pellet. Gun gives the over all appearance of a 50 caliber air cooled machine gun and is accurate up to a range of 100 feet. The self-contained feature of COMMANDO MACHINE GUN eliminates the inherent fault of any central compressor system and the usual annoying individual air lines. In the central compressor system, if the compressor breaks down, the entire gallery is out of commission with a total loss in income during the down time. Such complete disruption is virtually impossible with the self-contained COMMANDO MACHINE GUN.
2. TARGETS - Main Target as supplied with the COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERY consists of six rows of moving animals of various types.

Above the Main Target Assembly there is attached a unique attraction which is known as the "Prisoner Target". This Target moves back and forth across the width of the Gallery and when hit by one of the gunners, Target reverses direction.

Immediately in front of the Main Target is located a novel arrangement of three Rabbit Targets into which is incorporated an unusual "Drop Dead" action when any one of the rabbits is hit by a pellet.

The fourth component of the Main Target arrangement is in the extreme front of the entire Target assembly. This component consists of five Bullseyes, the centers of which are electrically wired and when struck by a pellet, the Bullseye actuates both an electric bell and a number indicator located directly above each Gun in front of the counter area.

All told, the COMMANDO MACHINE GUN Targets are novel in their action and fascinating in their appeal to the customer. In addition, various operators have found it expedient to hang various plastic and metal objects to be used as targets. These hanging objects are suspended from the ceiling directly above the Main Target Assembly.

3. BALL THROWING MECHANISM - As an adjunct to the other Machine Gun Targets, we supply a Ball Throwing Mechanism which is installed on the floor directly in front of the counter area. This device propels up the inclined floor Ping Pong type balls. Experience shows that this feature is a great crowd pleaser and is a welcome addition to the action packed COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERY.

4. PELLET RETURN TROUGH - This scientifically designed sheet metal trough is installed at the front lip of the slanted floor. The steel pellets roll down the incline, are collected in this trough, and channelled to the Pellet Washing Machine.
5. PELLET WASHING MACHINE - The Pellet Washing Machine as supplied with COMMANDO MACHINE GUN TARGET GALLERY is the result of three years constant experimentation. The ultimate product is an efficient machine which washes each pellet in an oil bath and then ejects the clean pellet into the loading bucket. The use of the Pellet Washing Machine eliminates any intermittent jamming which may result from foreign matter adhering to the surface of the pellet.
6. PLEXI-GLASS PROTECTION - Plexi-Glass Protection supplied with the Gallery has proven one of the greatest safety features ever devised for any type of shooting gallery installation. The Plexi-Glass gives unfailing protection to the customers against the danger of ricochet and, as such, is strongly recommended both by COMMANDO and safety authorities throughout the country.

1. *CASH ON LEASE IS PAYABLE AS FOLLOWS:

10% upon signing of lease. Balance of cash on lease to be paid 30 days prior to agreed shipping date.

2. **First rent payment is due and payable 40 days after shipping date. Succeeding rent payments due and payable each 30 days thereafter.

3. \$100.00 per gun unit deposit due and payable 30 days prior to agreed shipping date. This deposit is refundable to lessee upon receipt by Company of all equipment at termination of lease.

4. At termination of lease, lessee has option to purchase equipment covered by lease. 30% of amount paid in on 6 months lease, and, 25% of amount paid in on 12 months lease, will be applied against purchase price.

5. Company will supply spare gun, if lessee desires, at a rental of 50% of the amount normally charged as a rental for one (1) gun under terms of leasing agreement.

6. Company maintains comprehensive insurance coverage with Lloyds of London.

7. Company will renew lease for one (1) additional period at a rental not in excess of that rental indicated in the original lease.

8. Rentals are quoted F.O.B. Company's plant.

9. All equipment supplied under lease is covered by guarantee against defective parts for a period of 90 days from date of receipt.

10. Company will, if requested, instruct operator or operator's mechanic concerning operation and maintenance at Company's plant.
