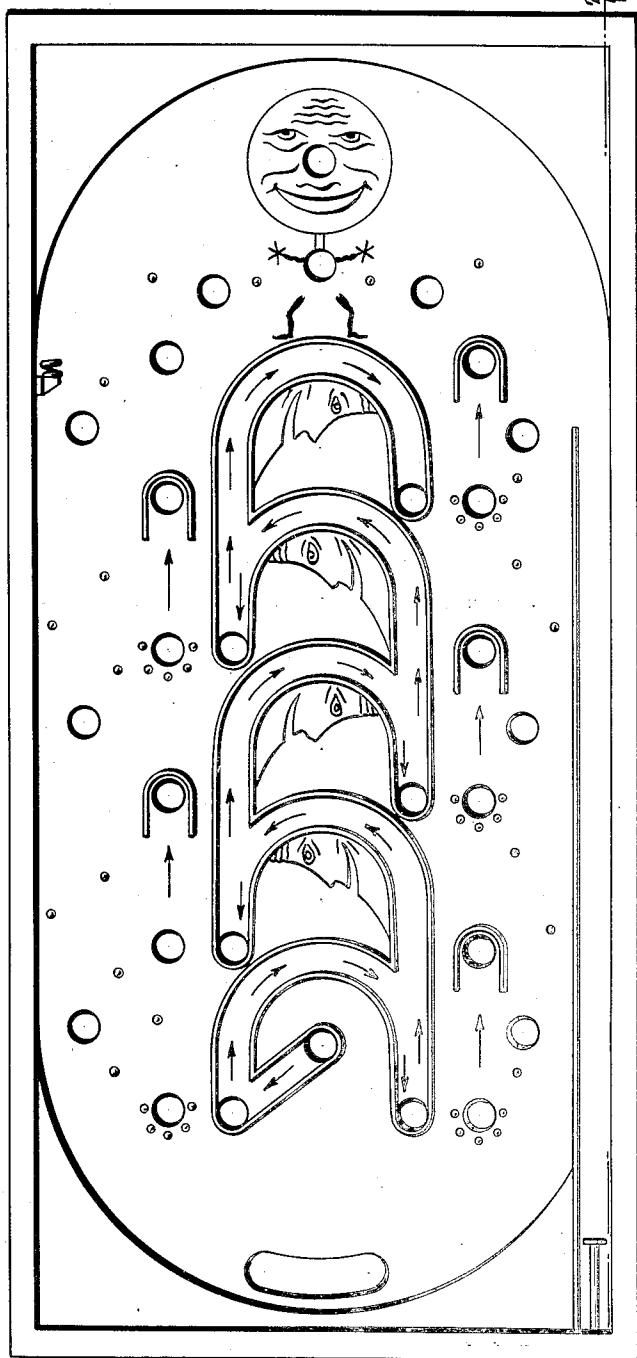

DESIGN FOR A PIN BOARD GAME DEVICE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert Stith Moorman, a citizen of the United States, residing at 325 West 71st Street, New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pin Board Game Device, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, Figure 1 is a plan view of a pin board game device, showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a longitudinal section of the same taken on the line 2—2 of Figure 1.
